A. Landscaping

i. Irrigation Issues

There's a busted ball valve that will require a plumber to fix, and then also receive a sign-off from the Town.

There was damage to a Bridge St power pedestal which is causing further irrigation problems on Bridge St. The foundation of the pedestal is the association's responsibility. The electricians on the job performed repairs & coordinated an inspection & ultimate approval by Town. Xcel had to inspect as well and it is now up & running.

Soledoids at Leapfrog & Rodeo Greens had to be replaced as well as a valve or 2 in those locations.

ii. Vern Johnson Park

New landscaping grass did not get established before it died. It's not exactly the proper type of area for sodding but Neils Lunceford is replacing & will keep a closer eye on it.
